From the Winemaker Stephen Chambers, 6th Generation SPRING UPDATE

In the winery and vineyard:

Currently in the winery Andrew has been racking the 2018 Shiraz and 2018 Durif from barrels in preparation for bottling later in the year and re-filling the barrels with the 2019 Shiraz and 2019 Durif. As a result of these transfers we will in the future have a 2018 Shiraz, 2018 Durif and a 2018 Shiraz Durif; some of which will be set aside as a sparkling red base wine. I am still assembling various fortified blends, filtering the blends and returning them to cask, currently it is the turn of the Rutherglen Tawny. Previously it was the Rutherglen Muscadelle and next will be the Rutherglen Muscat after I return from the tour of the USA with the Far from Ordinary series of events organised by Wine Australia. Catch up with Stephen and the rest of the Old Bridge Cellars stable in New York, Chicago, Miami, Dallas, Los Angeles and San Francisco beginning on the 19th September and concluding on 3rd October.

Out in the vineyard the vineyard staff are just finishing off the last of the pruning and tying down of the canes. It is expected that this task will be completed by the end of this week or the next. They have also been planting out our young vines from the nursery, fingers crossed that not only do we get some more rain to give these little vines the best start but we don't get too many frosts when they start to shoot.

On the farm:

Everything is looking green and lush on the farm though we could do with some more rain to keep the grass and crops growing. Currently we are receiving just enough rain to keep everything ticking along but a warm spell of weather could change the situation very quickly. Over the last 3 weeks we have been sending our cross-bred fat lambs into the local saleyards (Corowa). All the lambs sent have been in excess of 50kg with the prices averaging a 25% increase over last year however this increase could be a reflection of the lack of supply in the market and drought conditions. The expectation is that the price will ease as more new season sucker lambs enter the market .

We hope though the price will still be higher in comparison to 2018 with the next big event on the agenda is shearing which will take place in late October.
